Some of the subjects that will be of interest to members are these areas of interpreting: educational, interpreting in culturally diverse situations, deaf issues, deaf-blind, legal, religious, medical, mental health, and performing arts. Non-interpreting related topics could consist of, but not be limited to: finances for interpreters, technology, and personal relationships. The theme of the conference is to promote unity of mind, body, and soul.

## Compensation

### Compensation for Three (3) hour workshops

A payment of \$300 will be made to presentations for all instructional levels. (Presentations that are less than 3 hours in duration are considered professional discussions and will not receive compensation.) Presenters chosen for the conference will be expected to make preparation materials available to the Interpreter Coordinators one month prior to the conference.

### **Application process**

In order to be considered as a presenter at the 2006 TSID Conference please follow these procedures:

- 1) Complete the application form on the next page
- 2) Provide 3 copies of your proposal, which should not exceed two pages in length.
- 3) Provide a clear outline of your educational objectives for your proposed presentation.
- 4) Provide a one-paragraph summary of your proposal on diskette for a description in the conference program book.
- 5) Provide one paragraph biographical sketch of the presenter(s) on diskette.
- 6) Provide a resume.
- 7) Submit all materials no later than November 15, 2005 to:
